Evaluation Criteria

1. Governance Structure
2. Financial Transparency
3. External Oversight & Audit
4. Accountability to Stakeholders
5. Ethical & Integrity Standards

Scoring Framework

Each criterion is rated on a 0–5 scale:

- 0 = No evidence
- 1 = Minimal compliance
- 2 = Basic but insufficient
- 3 = Adequate compliance
- 4 = Strong practices
- 5 = Best practice / exemplary



Demonstration Results

Criterion	Score (0–5)	Comments
Governance Structure	4	Clear board structure, documented responsibilities.
Financial Transparency	3	Annual reports published but limited detail on expenses.
External Oversight & Audit	2	No recent external audit reports available.
Accountability to Stakeholders	3	Regular meetings, limited participation channels.
Ethical & Integrity Standards	4	Code of ethics exists, but monitoring mechanism limited.

Overall Transparency Rating

The fictional NGO received an average score of 3.2/5, which corresponds to a rating of **Moderate Transparency**. This suggests that while the organization shows commitment to openness and ethical practices, significant improvements are needed in external audits and stakeholder engagement.
